Whom we share your personal data with

The data will be processed by employees of the Controller's corporate function who have been expressly authorised to process the data and who have received appropriate operating instructions pursuant to Articles 29 of the GDPR. The legal basis for such processing is a legal obligation pursuant to Article 6(1)(c) of the GDPR.

Information received and reached during investigation are stored for a period of 5 years.
